### Notifications on Commencement of Offline Classes for Fifth Semester Students

Dear Students and Professors,

Regular offline classes for Fifth Semester students will commence from 8 February 2021 onwards as per the government notification. You are all requested to adhere to the following guidelines and arrangements made keeping in mind the COVID-19 SOP.

1. There will be offline classes only for the 5<sup>th</sup> Semester on Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 10.00 to 1.00pm. Noon shift for Commerce is from 2-4 pm. Night Shift Alumni College is from 3:30 – 5:30 pm. It is left to the department to continue with online classes as convenient.
2. Compulsory English classes for Arts, Science and Commerce should be held through Online mode only on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday
3. The Value Education classes will continue to be in the online mode.
4. The online classes will continue for the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> semesters until further notice. Kindly adjust so as not to clash with the offline classes of the 5<sup>th</sup> semester.
5. Post Graduate courses will have offline/online classes as per the decision of the department.
6. Professional Courses (Music, Media, BBA) kindly make halls arrangement as per your convenient.

8. Consent letter to be submitted by all the students of the 5<sup>th</sup> semester at the gate to the Official present there
9. COVID 19 Test Reports to be submitted by outstation students (from outside Meghalaya)
10. Students are to enter from the main gate only.
11. Students of the First and Third Semesters will not be allowed entry into the college until advised to do so. This is to avoid crowding in the campus.
12. All payments of fees etc. to be made by first and third semester students only through online mode.
13. Outstation students of the First and Third semesters are free to make arrangement for their stay in Shillong but their classes will be held only through online mode till further notice. They are not to visit the campus.
14. The First and Third Semester students will be informed about the commencement of offline classes.
15. Students of the Fifth Semester are advised to make arrangements for their stay and attending of offline classes between 3-7 February. Offline classes will begin from 8 February onwards.
16. Masks are to be worn at all times by students.
17. Personal hand sanitisers are to be brought by the students.
18. Tiffin and water are to be brought by the students as the canteens will remain closed.
19. Students are informed that once they enter the campus they will only be able to leave after the classes are over. And once they leave the campus during class hours they can only come back for the next day's classes.
20. Students are to stay only in the rooms allotted to them and not move to any other rooms during breaks. They can only move to other rooms when directed by their professors for holding of classes.
