



On September 3, 2025, the Department of Geology, St. Anthony's College held an interactive session with Dr. Kezhasilie Chiezou, Senior Geologist, Geological Survey of India. A total of 82 students from the Department of Geology attended this lecture.

Dr. Chiezou discussed geological mapping techniques, emphasizing on their importance in field work and data analysis. He outlined essential tools and methods used by geologists in the field and highlighted the broader applications of geological mapping. Dr. Chiezou also demonstrated how to locate oneself on a topographical map using theoretical knowledge and practical demonstrations. During his lecture he also elaborated on surface indicators of mineralization, such as gossan formation, malachite and azurite staining, and soil development.

The session concluded with an interactive Q&A, where students asked about geochemical mapping, entrance exams, and career opportunities in geology.
