

**10<sup>th</sup> Annual Rev.Fr. Noel Joseph Kenny Memorial Lecture(Online Mode)**  
**Held on 8<sup>th</sup> December,2021 from 2.30-4.30pm by (Rtd) Professor Mondakini**  
**Basu, Department of English, St.Anthony's College, Shillong**

**Topic: "Perspectives on Aristotle"**

The Department of English, St.Anthony's College, Shillong organised the 10<sup>th</sup> Annual Rev.Fr. Noel Joseph Kenny Memorial Lecture which was held on 8<sup>th</sup> December,2021 from 2.30-4.30pm.

The Lecture was delivered by (Retd) Prof.Mondakini Basu, Department of English, St.Anthony's College, Shillong on the topic entitled , "Perspectives on Aristotle"

The lecture covered the early life, career and influences of the ancient Greek philosopher Aristotle(384BC-322BC), his birthplace at Stagira(Northern Greece near Macedonia) and his departure for Athens to study under Plato, a renowned Greek philosopher in the Academy. On how he lived during the politically turbulent time and how he took refuge in the island of Lesbo for sometime until he was asked to tutor the young 13years old Alexander, and how the young Prince grew under his tutelage before he finally ascended the throne at 18 years of age whose empire ultimately stretched from the Balkans in Eastern Europe to Pakistan in Asia(East).

The lecture then delved into the 9 muses under the Greek pantheon eg. The muses of dance, music, drama etc. On how he founded Lysium(School) and engages in detailed discussions with his students. The lecture then went on the contribution that Aristotle made in various fields of knowledge. His famous Dialogues; Works of popular character; collection of scientific datas; systematic treatises;

In Sciennces- his contribution in the field of Theoretical science, Practical Science and Productive Science, his mastery over subjects like Linguistics, Economics etc, His books on metaphysics, politics, poetics, rhetorics; his collection of writings: collection of 158 constitutions, collection of visitors at the olympics, the libraries of antiquities, dramatic contest and records of winners of contests

His theory on Tragedy (a part of Poetics) discusses Aristotle description of Tragedy as an imitation of an action. Imitation as a basis of all knowledge and a psychical activity.

The talk then focusses another perspective of Aristotle on Artists as those who can imitate things not as they are but in accordance to their sense perception and understanding of tragedy as an imitation of men in action. The classical Greek Sophoclean tragedy based on oedipus trilogy and the role of pity and fear in tragedy. Further the lecture discusses the aim of tragedy which was to arouse pity and fear and purge it through catharsis. On how pity is arouse for someone else and fear is for oneself. The act of creation illustrated by the carpenter who has an idea, the table whereby the idea is conceptualised and materialised, the poet/artist who describe it as being thrice removed from reality.Overall the lecture was highly enriching.

The Drama Club of the Department conducted a Workshop and Talk on Theatre in the Digital Space in the College Auditorium on 26 December 2021. Ms. Lapdang Syiem, National School of Drama and Commedia School graduate, animated the workshop and through lecture and demonstration was able to disseminate information on Digital Theatre, its origins, and present practices.

Objective: To showcase to the participants the many ways in which Digital Theatre has revitalized theatre for the contemporary audience by utilizing both live actors and co-present audience along with digital media.

Outcome: the participants thoroughly enjoyed the sessions conducted by the Resource Person and were grateful for her insights on an aspect of Drama that was new to them.

## Course Objective

Following their curiosity by way of research will be one of the classes which will be followed by classes on the use of technology to the students' advantage, illustrations, graphics. Classes on documentary photography will also be taken to introduce to the students the idea of reportage. (4 credits)

## Part V: Plagiarism and Copyright

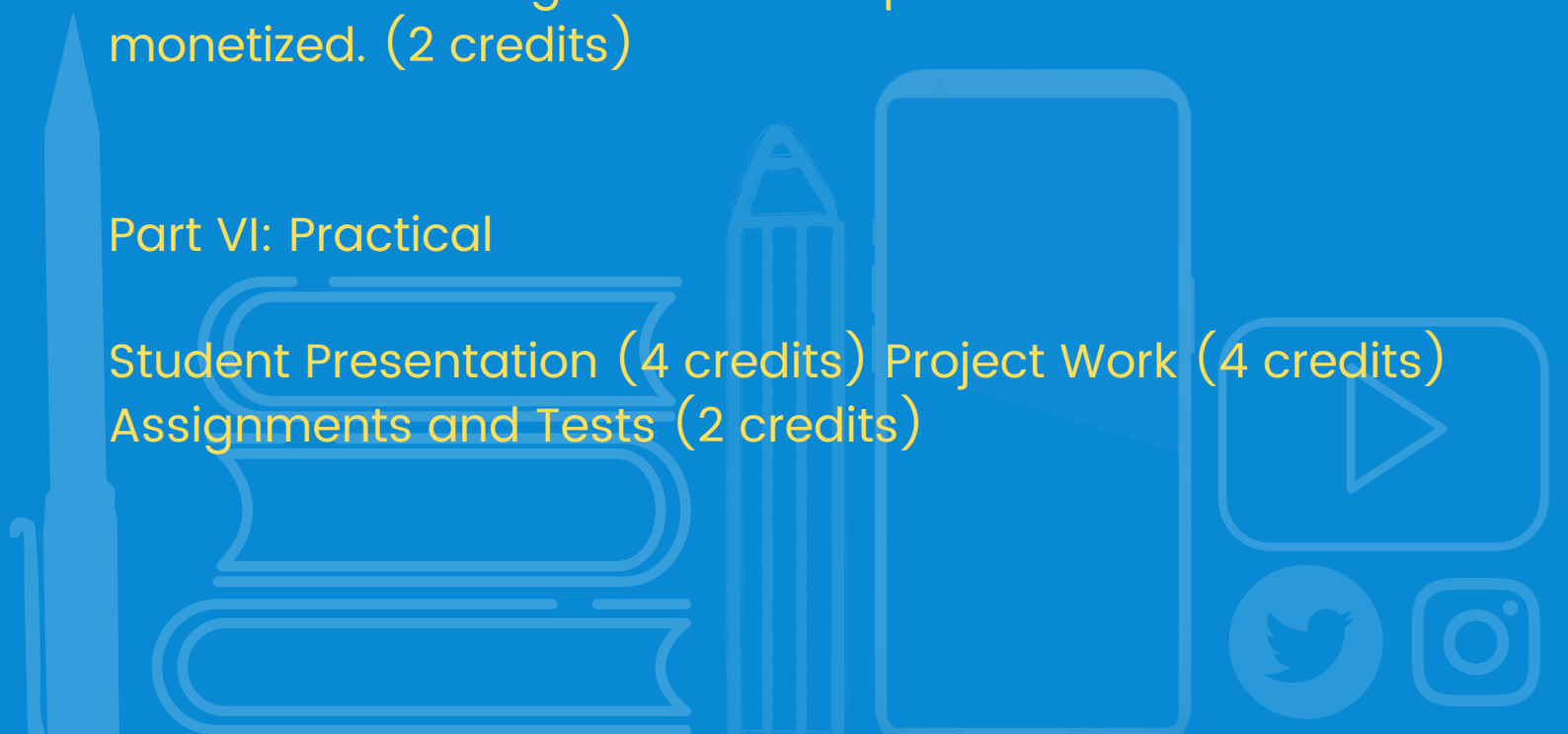
