This awareness program was conducted by National Institute of Electronics & Information Technology (NEILIT) and Computer Science department of St. Anthony's College, Shillong

The aim of this three-day awareness program was to not only create more awareness about the threats that are present in the virtual world of the internet but also to enhance students' knowledge on the various e-facilities such as the e-gadgets available.

This event consisted of about 100 female students from various streams and departments of the college.

On the first day i.e March 28th the first session was conducted by Mr. Gordon Kynsai Nongkynrih on the topics – cyber security, importance of cyber security, types of frauds such as phishing, romance scam, doxing and sim swap, and threats such as social



engineering, online sextortion, ransomware, digital payment, safe browsing and ways on using safe digital payment.

Mr. Nongkynrih's session not only enlightened the students with the various threats lurking in the virtual world but also showed the various ways through which we can safely browse the internet.

On the second day of the program i.e March 29th the first session was conducted by Ms.Saritamala Devi on the topics- IT and ICT tools which are used in education, agriculture, medical field and even transportation; she also elaborated on the various threats that are present when using websites, apps and digital devices



The second session of the day was taken up by Ms. Sibalin War, she showed the practical method for performing online transactions using the various apps and suggested the students a number of safe transaction apps such as Google Pay, Bharat Pay etc.



On the last day of the event i.e March 30th the first session was conducted by Sir Bimal D Swer who elaborated on the topics of Internet Of Things, the use of the internet in the early years, how the huge network known as the internet came about. Furthermore, Mr.

Swen summarized briefly on the topics that were done during the early days of the program.



For the last session of the event Mr. Manbha Khongkhlad showed us the steps to apply for scholarship, ST and SC certificates online. He also discussed on the importance and usefulness of digital locker. This session clarified the doubts of the participants and showed us a very easy way to apply for scholarships, certificates and get information about the various schemes introduced by the government.



This three day event enlightened all the participants with new knowledge and gave the insight about the importance safe use of internet and also equipped the participants with the various e-gadgets that can be readily used at just the fingertips of the hands and save time and money. Another important lesson drawn from this seminar was to educate family members about the same, and encourage and promote on the safe use of the Internet.
