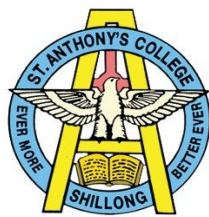

1. Introduction

The CUET-UG Coaching Program was initiated by the Students Development Services (SDS) & Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), St. Anthony's College, Shillong to assist students in preparing for the Common University Entrance Test (CUET-PG) 2023-2024 for Postgraduate admissions. This report outlines the objectives, structure, execution, and outcomes of the coaching program conducted during the academic year 2023-2024.

2. Objective of the Coaching Program

The primary objectives of the CUET-PG Coaching Program are:

- To provide comprehensive and targeted preparation for CUET-PG aspirants.

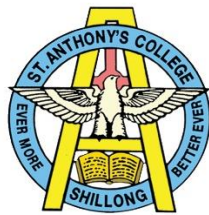

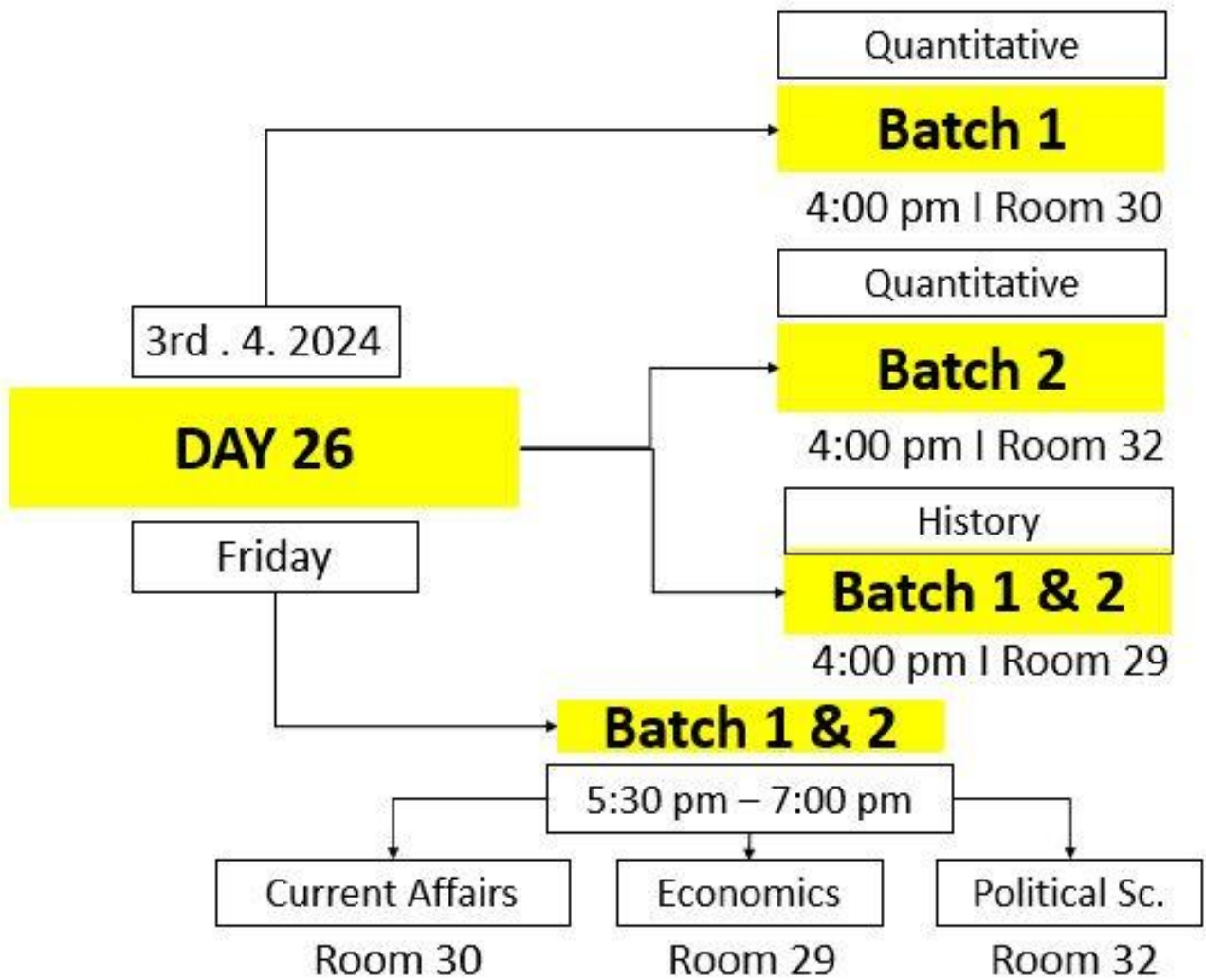
