



St. Anthony's College Freeship for Underprivileged Students

The Evening Shift of the College, supported by the St. Anthony's College, Shillong Alumni Association (SACSAA), is aimed at providing access to quality education to students who are either from an economically disadvantaged background or who are academically underachieving. The aim of this programme is to give these students an opportunity to make a career for themselves and to further encourage such students in their pursuit of higher education. Therefore, St. Anthony's College, Shillong offers a freeship by way of a partial fee-waiver for such deserving students. Such students are charged a modest sum of Rs. 5000/- per year. The fee waiver is between Rs. 12000 to Rs. 15000.

Objectives of the Freeship

To encourage students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds achieve academic success.

Eligibility

- Students belonging to BPL/AAY (Antyodaya Anna Yojana) category enrolled in the SACSAA-enabled Evening Shift.
- Meritorious Students from the Evening Shift deemed fit by the College Management

Procedure of Selection:

The students are identified to be eligible for Freeship through an interview process by an Interview board consisting of the members of the College Management, Teachers and Alumni.

Fees to be exempted

Students awarded the partial fee-waiver are to pay Rs. 5000/- per year. This amount would be reimbursed to the student on the condition that they graduate from the Bachelors programme with First Class Results (Scoring $\geq 60\%$) and have achieved at least 75% attendance.

Duration of the partial fee-waiver

The partial fee-waiver shall be awarded to students deemed eligible by the College Management at the time of admission. The candidates shall pay only the mandatory fee component of Rs 5000/- only.
