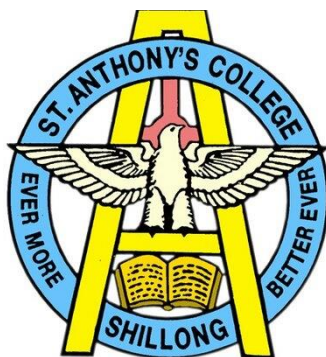
RESPECT FOR PROPERTY
