The Department of Geology, St. Anthony's College had conducted coaching classes for the final year students who were determined to sit for Joint admission test (JAM-2016), CUCET (Central Universities Common Entrance Test (2016) and other relevant entrance exams for pursuing MSc Master's degree programme at various prestigious universities and Institutes in India.

The main objective of the programme was to teach topics that were not covered in the undergraduate programme i.e., B.Sc syllabus. Therefore, special emphasis was laid to focus on the topics that are as per the syllabus of JAM and CUCET. Coaching conducted during the programme was in the form of group discussions, presentations and explanations. Special importance was given to numerical calculation and solving previous year question papers.

The programme started from 2nd June to 1st September 2015 with a total of 46 hours duration and altogether twenty-eight final year students of 2016 batch participated in the programme. The outcome of the programme have greatly benefited the students .

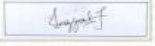

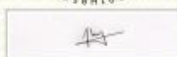
