Programmes and Activities undertaken by AYC (2016-2019)

With ideas, commitment, active participation and knowledge from the members, the Club was able to conduct and organized the following activities and programs-

Activities of the year 2016:-

1. Basic Life Support Workshop:

Date: 14th May 2016

Venue: St. Anthony's College, Shillong.

A workshop on basic life support was organized by the Anthonian Youth Club in the college to teach the students about the importance of First Aid Skills and how to react during emergency situation and accidents.

The resource person of the workshop was Miss Riorita K Syiemiong, a nursing tutor (BLS & ACLS Instructor (AHA) Rapsbun Nursing School along with the Principal of Rapsbun Nursing School and some other staffs assisted the whole workshop.

The workshop was organised only for the Club members. Certificates were also given to the participants.

2. Inter-school Poster Competition:

Date: 30th May 2016

Venue: Premises of Seven schools competed.

The Anthonian Youth Club organized an Inter-school Poster Competition to observe 'World No Tobacco Day'. Seven schools competed in this competition: (i) Brookside Adventist Higher Secondary School, (ii) Laitumkhrah Presbyterian Higher Secondary School, (iii) May Fair School, (iv) Mizo Modern Higher Secondary School, (v) Pine Mount School, (vi) St. Anthony's Higher Secondary School, (vii) St. Edmund's Higher Secondary School. The competition was carried out in the respective premises of the seven schools. Members of the Club volunteered to managed the event.

3. World No Tobacco Day Awareness Campaign:
