Thrust Areas of the College

Academics

The Department of Botany organised a workshop on “Vermicomposting” for the Sixth Semester Botany students at the Vermicomposting unit of the Botanical Garden of the College. The resource persons were Dr. C. S. Rao and Prof. D. Bokolial. The 3rd Online/blended lecture on Chemical Ecology entitled “Biogeography: Studying the distribution of species across space” was held on 9 March 2018. The lecture which was organised by the Biotech Hub was delivered by Dr. Uma Ramakrishnan, Faculty, NCBS, Bangalore through a Facebook link. A programme titled E-Waste Mangement was organised by the Computer Science Department from 23-25 March 2018.

A poetry workshop was organised by the Department of English on 24 March 2018 with Mr. Annirudh Eka as the Resource Person. An Intra-Departmental Seminar for the students was organised by the Department of Chemistry on 24 March 2018. The Department of Botany organised a lecture for its students on the topic, “Tracking trees through season watch”, on 28 March 2018. The Resource Persons were Dr. Geetha Ramaswami and Dr. Swati Sidhu from IISC, Bangalore. The students of the Department of Geology were given two-day field training under the guidance of Mr. M. A. Khonglah, Senior Geologist, GSI, Shillong on 11 and 12 April 2018. The Resource Person imparted field training in the areas of Mairang, Nongstoin and Umsning, East Khasi Hills, to the Sixth Semester Geology students on the recognition of rocks and measurement of rock structures and field mapping. This was preceded by a talk on Geological Structures and Geology of Meghalaya on 10 April 2018 which was delivered to the students of fourth semester.

The Final Year Presentation on Entrepreneurship was held for the 6th Semester students of the BBA Department. This presentation was conducted as part of their academic evaluation. The DBT sponsored Institutional Biotech Hub in collaboration with the Dept. of Biotechnology and Biochemistry organised a Summer Training programme 13-15 June 2018. The participants included B.Sc 6th semester students of the departments of Biochemistry, Biotechnology and Zoology. The Biotechnology and Zoology students were placed in one group and were trained in *Protein Isolation and Purification* and *Synthetic Seed production* by Prof. V.M. Wann and Prof. S. Lyndem. The Biochemistry students on the other hand were trained by Prof. S. Thabah and Prof A. M. Susngi in *DNA Isolation, Quantification, Polymerase Chain Reaction and Restriction Digestion*.

The Department of Mass Media organised ***A Talk on Journalism, Storytelling and Digital Platform*** as a part of the Media Entrepreneurship and Marketing Paper on 25 July 2018 for the Media Technology students of the 5th Semester. Mr. Samrat Choudhury, Editor, The Asian Age, Mumbai Edition, was the invited Resource Person. The Department of Mass Media coordinated the shoot of ‘Campus Buzz’ (a TV programme) in the college premises, under the aegis of NE LIVE, a Guwahati based Channel from 24 July to 26 July 2018. This event gave students an opportunity to exhibit their talents in a variety of ways. The Department of Mass Media organised a Sound Workshop on Radio ***Broadcast- Mixing and Sound Designing*** from 25 July to 27 July 2018 for the 5th Semester Media Tech students. Yuni Yoomi Shylla was the invited expert on this instance.

An Interactive Session and Training on ***Entrepreneurship and Marketing*** for the students of 5th Semester Media Tech was organised on 28 July 2018 by the Department of Mass Media.

They were guided by Dr Daisy Hassan, University of Westminster and Mr. Pradyot Deb Barman, Activist and Writer. The Department of Mizo on 6 August 2018 organised a National Seminar on Mizo Literature to commemorate the Birth Centenary of L. Biakliana (1918-1941), the First Mizo Novelist. The Chief Guest was Dr. Manas Ranjan Mahapatra, Director, I&PR, NEC. The keynote address was delivered by Prof. Dr. Lalitluangliana Khiantge, Padmashree Awardee & Head of Department, Mizo, Mizoram University. A Talk cum Interaction Programme was conducted on 11 August 2018 by the Department of Physics for the students of the department. The resource person for the programme was Prof. Saurabh Basu from the Department of Physics, Indian Institute of Technology, Guwahati. He is also the Dean of Outreach Education Programme of IIT, Guwahati. A lecture was delivered by him on the topic *Preparation for entrance exams and the way ahead after graduation*.

The Department of Computer Science hosted the 4th National Conference on Emerging Trends and Applications in Computer Science (NCETACS-2018) on 14 and 15 September 2018. Shri James P.K Sangma, Minister of Home, Law, Power, District Council Affairs, Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Govt. of Meghalaya was the Chief Guest for the Inaugural Programme. Dr. Rashmi Dutta Baruah, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Computer Science & Engineering, IIT, Guwahati delivered a talk on *On Interpretability of Neural Networks*. The Department of Khasi organized a Special Lecture on 15 September 2018 for the students of the Department. The theme of the lecture was *Ka Subject Khasi ha ka pule Puthi*. The Resource person for this lecture was Mrs. P. Syiem, Former Head of the Department of Khasi, St. Anthony's College, Shillong.

The Mass Media Department in collaboration with Sasakawa Peace Foundation, Japan and Yamagata International Documentary Film Festival, Japan hosted a Documentary Film Workshop for students and faculty of the department on 4 and 5 December 2018. Yui Nakamura, Sasakawa Peace Foundation, Japan, Ms. Asako Fujioka, Board of Director, YIDFF & Mr. Katsuyoshi KUSAKABE, Festival Director, YIDFF provided useful insights on the art of film making. Maulee Senapati provided an additional insight into the Challenges of Documentary making in North East India. The Department of BBA in collaboration with XLRI Jamshedpur from 13 – 15 December 2018 organised a Conference on Entrepreneurship Innovation and Society. The resource persons from XLRI Jamshedpur were Prof. Madhukar Shukla, Prof. Venugopal Pingali, Prof. Indrajeet Mukherjee and Prof. Teidorlang Lyngdoh. The keynote address was delivered by Prof. Madhukar Shukla who focussed on entrepreneurship and the disparities that exist in India in terms of the wealthy and the poor and malnourished.
