## ***Thrust Areas of the College***

### **Academics**

The Department of Zoology organised an Invited Lecture on the theme ***Biospeleology and Caves of Meghalaya*** on 1 March 2019. Dr. Daniel Harries, Heriot-Watt University, Edinburgh, Scotland, and Mr. Bryan Daly Kharpran (President, Meghalaya Adventure Association) were the Resource Persons for this event. The Department of Philosophy in collaboration with the Department of Hindi organised a National Seminar on ***Mahatma Gandhi's Philosophy and His Vision of the World Today and Tomorrow*** on 7 and 8 March 2019. The seminar was sponsored by ICSSR NEHU. The Department of Botany organised a half-day training session on 11 March 2019 for 6<sup>th</sup> Semester Honours students on ***Vermicomposting*** in the Botanical Garden of the College premises. Mr. S. Kharraswai, the in-charge of the college waste management unit of the Botanical Garden delivered a lecture which offered meaningful insights on vermicomposting.

The Women Anti-Harassment Cell was constituted to help maintain a harmonious atmosphere at the Institute, to enable women to pursue their work with dignity and reassurance. The functions of the Cell are primarily to provide them with a platform for filing their complaints and to expedite their resolution. It also provides an environment where the aggrieved person is given the confidence to air their grievances without fear of bias and criticism. It also tries to empower the female members of the College by making them aware of their legal rights and the different methods available under the legal system to redress their grievances.

Any complaint to the WAH Cell filed by an individual/group of individuals which has been proven to false or frivolous will result on a substantial fine which shall be imposed on the complainant or complainants, and the quantum of the fine shall be recommended by the members of the said Cell to the competent authority.

Anyone found to have harassed another will be subjected to appropriate disciplinary action, including:

- Reprimand/s and/ or written apology,
- Suspension from classes/practical work, etc.,
- Other punishment/s as prescribed by the Law, and/or the University Act.
