Thrust Areas of the College

Academics

The Northeast India AV Archive conceptualized an audio visual travelling exhibition to take the archive to the field and educate the youth of the state about how Meghalaya attained statehood and exhibit material relating to the personalities who led the statehood movement. After a successful pilot exhibition at Pynursla on Meghalaya Day The Northeast India Audio Visual Archive organized a two-day audio-visual exhibition at Baghmara and Siju, South Garo Hills, Meghalaya on the 24th and 25th of February, 2021 respectively. The exhibition showcased a collection of photographs, documents and archival video clips from the Pre-Hill State Movement to the early years of Meghalaya. The exhibition was inaugurated by the Chief Minister of Meghalaya, Shri. Conrad K. Sangma in the presence of Shri. Rakkam A. Sangma, (MLA, Rongara Siju Constituency), Shri. Thomas A. Sangma (MLA, North Tura Constituency) and other dignitaries at Baghmara. The exhibition was also attended by students from the two towns. A large number of students were from Capt. Williamson Sangma Govt. Memorial College, Baghmara, and St. John's Secondary School, Siju. Many residents of the two towns also visited the exhibition.

The IQAC, St. Anthony's College organised a two-day workshop in the premises of the college on "*Preparedness for NAAC Assessment and Accreditation under revised framework 2020*" for administrators and faculty of four colleges of Meghalaya who are preparing for their 1st Cycle of Assessment and Accreditation under National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). On 28 and 29 January 2021 the workshops for the administrators and faculty of St. Francis D'Assisi College, Siejlieh, Nongstoin, West Khasi Hills; Balawan College, Umsning, Ri Bhoi and St. Anthony's College Extension Campus, Byndihati, East Jaintia Hills was held and attended by over 65 participants.

The Department of Zoology, St. Anthony's College organised a "Hands-on Training Workshop on Molecular Biology" for the students of the 6th semester on 26-27 February 2021. The Resource persons were George Calvis Shabong (JRF) and the Faculty of the department of Zoology. The programme was sponsored by DST-SERB.

A guest lecture on 'Earthquake detection through remote sensing and total electron content (TEC) with special reference to N.E. India' was organised for first semester, third semester and fifth semester students of Geology department by the Department of Geology, St. Anthony's College on 27th February 2021. The resource person for the day was Mr. Karan

Nayak, M.Sc., Applied Geology, Central University of Karnataka. He is currently working as Project Support Services at NESAC (North Eastern Space Application Centre) Umiam, Meghalaya. He is also an alumnus of the Geology department, SAC. The talk was divided into two parts, in the first part students were given all the basics about earthquakes, calculation of magnitude and intensity of an earthquake, damage caused by earthquakes and also the safety measures that should be taken during an earthquakes. The second part of the talk included more technical aspects of the topic and the students were shown how data collected through total electron content in the ionosphere can be used to predict earthquake in days in advance. A case study was also shown to students for their better understanding.

An Add-on Course on Bee Biology and Beekeeping was organised by the Department of Zoology from 13-19 April 2021. The participants were 6th Semester. The Resource Persons were Mr. Joseph Basumatary, Head, Beekeeping, Rural Resource Training Centre, Umran and the Faculty of Zoology Department, St. Anthony's College, Shillong. The course was partially sponsored by the Alumni of the Department of Zoology.

The Department of English, St. Anthony's College hosted an Online Guest Lecture on the topic "Shakespeare's Clowns with reference to Fester" with Prof. Toony Gill, retired Head of the Department of English, St. Mary's College, Shillong as the Resource Person on 22 April 2021. The programme was organised as a commemoration of the birth anniversary of England's and one of the world's greatest poets and dramatists, William Shakespeare which falls on the 23rd April every year.

The Department of English organised a virtual guest lecture to commemorate the 87th Foundation Day of the Department on the theme "Unmasking Jimmy Porter: A Semiotic Reading" for the students of the Department on 18th June 2021. The Resource Person was Prof. Cherry K. Kharshiing, Department of Mass Media, SAC.

The Library Coordination Team and IQAC, SAC, organised a webinar on 18th June 2021 on the topic "From Textbooks to Journals with J-Gate" to create an awareness and acquaint students of the available online facilities to access the college library and e-resources therein. Mr. Mahendranath Sarkar, Training and Development Manager, J-Gate enlightened the students on the topic.

The Department of Computer Science organised an online lecture series on the topic “Data Mining for All” for students of various colleges on 25th June 2021. The Resource Person was Dr. Anjan Das, Associate Professor, St. Anthony’s College.

The PG Department of Education and the Department of Statistics under aegis of IQAC, SAC, organised a hands-on training on MS Office Essentials and Digital Technology from 9th August -31st August 2021. The Resource Persons were Prof. Bablu L. Rajak, Department of Computer Science, Prof. Omprakash Yadav, Department of Computer Science, Prof. Kesterlee L. Syiemiong, Department of Computer Science and Prof. Lemuel Rapsuk, Department of Computer Science.

A Virtual Orientation Programme was organised on 17th September 2021 by the Department of Value Education for the students of the 1st semester B.A, B.Sc, B.Com and B.B.A. Prof. S. M Syiemlieh, Staff Coordinator, SAC highlighted the rules and regulations of the college to our freshers.
