

Thrust Areas of the College

Academics

The Department of Geology in collaboration with Geological Survey of India Training Institute, Regional Training Division, North Eastern Region, GSITI (RTDNER), Shillong, conducted a three-day training programme from 14th March to 16th March 2022, for the final year 6th Semester students of Department of Geology, St. Anthony's College, Shillong. On the first day, a lecture on Introduction to Geological Mapping with special reference to Toposheets was given followed by visits to the Geotechnical, and Geochemistry Laboratories and Geological Museum of GSI. On the other two days, Field training to Mairang and Cherrapunji was conducted and guided by Dr B.N Mahanta, Director of GSITI (RTDNER), Shillong and Mr. Hiruj Saikia, Senior Geologist, GSI, Shillong.

The Cyber Club, of the Department of Computer Science, conducted two batches of short-term courses in the month of March-April 2022. The first course had participants from non-computer science background and the teachers from the 6th semester BSc Computer Science. The total number of participants that successfully completed this course were 62.

The Department of English, SAC hosted a Poetry Reading Session to commemorate World Poetry Day on 21st March 2022. The open invitation to students of the college to read their poems in this platform evoked an overwhelming response.

The first and fourth Semester students of Department of Geology, St. Anthony's College, were taken for an industrial visit to Central Seismological Observatory, Indian Meteorological Department and Shillong Geophysical Research Centre on 24th March 2022.

The Department of Mass Media organized an interaction with the students of Don Bosco School, Silchar on 1st April 2022. About 40 Students from Don Bosco School, Silchar participated. The school had recently introduced 'Mass Media' subject as part of their syllabus. Students of the 6th Semester Mass Communication and Video Production with the Head of the Department and the Director welcomed them and had an interactive session.

The students of the second semester Mass Communication and Video Production had a Storyboard Workshop with Mr. Ban Casper Mawlong the owner of Cosmic Clusters which is a Shillong-based company, on 1st April 2022.

About 32 students of the 4th Semester Media Technologies visited the two FM station in Shillong i.e., 93.5 Red FM and 91.1 Radio Mirchi on 5th April 2022, both of which are a network of nationwide radio channels that operate round the clock. The students had the opportunity to meet the programming team led by the producer and also to interact with the different Radio Jockeys. In the day long visit, the students gained experience of a live broadcast, the nitty gritty of the working of FM radio stations and the art of radio jockeying. They also attended sessions on social media and its impact on the radio broadcast.

The Department of English, SAC for organized a Three-Day Seminar and Workshop from 19th-21st April 2022, on Research Paper Writing for Undergraduates (Humanities) for 6th Semester students of the Department of English. The Resource Persons were Dr. Quendirisa Kharbuli, North Eastern Hill University (NEHU), Dr. Cherry Kordor Kharshiing, Department of Mass Media, SAC and Dr. Amanda C. Tongper, Department of English, SAC.

The Department of Biotechnology organised a Live Interactive Session for the students of the department entitled "Taking the Business Route" with Prof. Gracyl Syiemiong, Department of Business Administration, SAC on 26th April 2022.

A hands-on training on basics of bioinformatics was organized by the Biochemistry and Biotechnology Department from 2^{nd} to 13^{th} May 2022. The Resource person was Dr. B. J. Mylliemngap for the students of 6^{th} semester of the Department.

The Media Club of St. Anthony's College, Shillong celebrated the World Press Freedom Day on 3rd May 2022, which the United Nations considers as extremely significant. The celebration provides an opportunity to celebrate the fundamental principles of press freedom, assess the state of press freedom across the globe, defend the attacks on media independence, and pay tribute to the journalists who sacrifice their lives in the line of duty.

The Department of Mizo organized an Inter-College Debate Competition on 6th May 2022, on the theme "Active Participation of Youths in Politics is necessary for Transformation of Nation and Society". The chief guest, Dr. Vanalaltanpuia, Chairman, Mizoram Youth Commission. The Speaker of the debate was Prof. B. Lalruatpuii, ICFAI University, Mizoram.

The Department of Chemistry organized an intradepartmental students' seminar to acquaint the 6th semester students with various topics to B.Sc. honours on 14th May 2022. The objectives of the programme were to encourage the 6th Semester Chemistry Honours students to conduct project reports based on literature survey, under the guidance of faculty and make a presentation at the seminar.

The Department of Chemistry made an educational tour to Meghalaya State Pollution Control Board, Shillong on 17th May 2022, to expose the Chemistry honours students to the practical applications of the principles of Green Chemistry – its techniques and procedures.

The Department of Physics in collaboration with Centre of Plasma Physics, IPR Sonapur, Assam conducted a one-day workshop on 18th July 2022, on Popularization of Plasma Physics for the students of the department to commemorate "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav".
