as Section 12-B w.e.f. 1st. October, 1984 - Regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to say that the University Grants Commission (Amendment) Act, 1984 has come into force w.e.f. 1st. October, 1984 vide notification No.F.1.2-7/84-Desk-U dated 1st. October, 1984 issued by the Ministry of Education & Culture, Govt. of India, published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary (Part II, Section 3-Sub-Section (ii). Section 3 of the UGC (Amendment) Act, 1984 provides that in the principal Act of 1956, Section 12-A is to be renumbered as Section 12-B. The effect of the UGC (Amendment) Act, 1984 would be that w.e.f. 1st. October, 1984 Section 12-A of the Principal UGC Act, 1956 would read as Section 121B, which would include the rules previously made under this Section.

This modification is brought to the notice of the University for information and appropriate action.

It is requested that this may be brought to the notice of all the colleges/institutions within the jurisdiction of your University.

The UGC Act, 1956 (as modified upto 1st. October, 1984) is being printed. A copy of the UGC Act, 1956 will be made available to the University in due course.

Sub: Sanction of adhoc grant to identified colleges under the scheme of “Colleges with Potential for Excellence” (CPE).

Sir,

This is in continuation of this office letter No. F.12-1/2004 (NS/PE) dated 19.05.2006 addressed to Vice-Chancellors and copy marked to the Registrars and to the concerned colleges regarding selection of colleges under CPE Scheme.

In this regard, I am to convey the sanction of the Commission for payment of Rs.30,00,000/- (Rupees thirty lakhs only) to **St. Anthony's College, Bomfyle Road, Shillong-793001** as adhoc grant for (a) improving academic infrastructure, (b) adopting innovations in teaching, learning and evaluation and (c) initiating the activities under the scheme of CPE. The finer details will be spelt out after an interface meeting with Expert Committee, details of which will be sent to the Colleges in due course. In the meanwhile, the Colleges may prepare an Action Plan in line with the Guidelines of CPE.

The details of the adhoc grant being released are given below:-

* The above allocation is as per the guidelines on CPE. In case, your college has obtained NAAC Accreditation and/or autonomous status after submission of your proposal under CPE scheme, kindly send a copy of NAAC letter and/or UGC letter conferring autonomous status so that the above allocation may be revised.

1. The sanctioned amount is debitable to the major head 4.1.2 and is valid for payment during the financial year 2006-07 only.
2. The above amount may be kept in a separate Saving Bank A/c of your Bank.
3. **The above grant may be utilised only after receiving the approval from UGC with reference to your budget Proposal for the years 2006-2007 to 2008-2009, for which an interface meeting is to be held at UGC office shortly.** A separate Communication shall be sent to the Colleges in this regard in due course.
4. The amount of grant shall be drawn by the Under Secretary (Drawing & Disbursing Officer), University Grants Commission on the Grants-in-aid bill and shall be disbursed to and credited to the **Principal, St. Anthony's College, Bomfyle Road, Shillong-793001** through Demand Draft/Mail Transfer.


5. The grant is subject to the adjustment on the basis of Utilization Certificate in the prescribed proforma submitted by the Institution/college.
6. The College shall maintain proper accounts of the expenditure out of the grants which shall be utilized only on approved items of expenditure.
7. The Utilization Certificate to the effect that the grant has been utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned shall be furnished to the University Grants Commission by 15th April of every financial year.
8. The assets acquired wholly or substantially out of the University Grants Commission's Grant shall not be disposed or encumbered or utilized for the purposes other than those for which the grant was given, without proper sanction of the University Grants Commission and should, at any time the College ceased to function, such assets shall revert to the University Grants Commission.
9. A register of Assets acquired wholly or substantially out of the grant shall be maintained by the College in the prescribed form.
10. The College shall follow strictly all the instructions issued by the Government of India from time to time with regard to reservation of posts for Scheduled Casts and Scheduled Tribes.
11. The College shall fully implement the Official Language Policy of Union Govt. and comply with the Official Language Act, 1963 and Official Language (use for official purpose of the Union) Rules, 1976 etc.
12. The Sanction issues in exercise of the delegation of powers vide Commission office order no.25/92 dated May, 01,1992.
13. The funds to the extent are available under the scheme.
14. The terms and conditions of the grant will be as applicable during the X Plan for the colleges.
