PURPOSE OF THE MOU:

- 1. Enrolling the final year students every year/ past students data on App & Job Portal
- 2. Verification of the students
- 3. Access to JPN staff to address the students on the services provided by JPN
- 4. JPN promotional materials to be displayed in the college notice boards.
- 5. Permission to JPN team to bring in companies to recruit the students/organising Job Fair/Mela in the college
- 6. JPN will organise and coordinate Soft Skills Training for the students on need-basis. For which the individual institutes will pay a stipulated amount as training cost. (A list of topics will be provided by JPN. The institute could request other topics on need basis)
- 7. JPN will coordinate ONE placement drive towards the end of the final semester every year. A fee for which will be collected from the individual institute if needed
- 8. JPN will organise an annual Webinar on a subject related to career and placement in consultation with the respective institute
- 9. JPN will provide connectivity between students and the recruiters for Placement
- 10. The institute will appoint a local placement coordinator as reference person
- 11. The Placement coordinator is responsible to collect and manage student data
- 12. Respective institutes are responsible for the logistic and hospitality of the programmes and personnel who come for training and placement programmes
- Each institute should provide space for JPN in its premises to exhibit and promote related materials
- 14. To ascertain the eligibility and preparedness of the registered candidates JPN will organise module tests in which the candidates are expected to score 60%. Of these JPN will ensure 7% of placement to the candidates with the companies
- 15. Services of JPN comes at an annual subscription based on the locality and number of students, as shown below:
